It has been the practice to grant recognition to schools for a limit period and such recognition used to lapse on the expiry of that period us such recognition was renewed before the expiry of that period

based on Rule 54(2) of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973. In C. No. 333 of 1977 in the case of Digamber Jain Society, the Hon'ble H. of Delhi Delivered a Judgement on 30-8-1979 holding Rule 54(2) ult of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973. The operational portion the said Judgement reads here as under:-

of the Act and Rules, I am of the opinion that Rule 54(2) is ultra vires of the Act, and that recognition originally granted to the school was an absolute recognition; at any rate, the recognition granted after 31-12-7. The must be treated as the absolute grant of recognition within the scope of rule 54. It must be deemed that the authority was satisfied that after some time the school will be able to fulfil the requirements and conditing grant of recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemply was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so the recognication to be taken away from the school except in the manns contamplated by Section 4 sub-sec. (4) or (6)".

The prescribed Authority (Administrator of Delhi-Lt.Governor) announce his judgement on 9-11-79 in the case of Appeal No. 143/79-G.A. in the case of Bahar Education Trust Vs. State as here under:-

In view of the Law laid down by the Delhi HightCourt in the case of Digambar Jain Society, it has been held, and I hold accordingly that the sellant school continued to be recognised school. In case the Direct of ducation is of the opinion that the school does not datisfy any one of the condition specified under Sub-section (1) of Section 4, he will have to follow the procedure laid down under Sub-section (6) of Section 4 read with rule 56".

In view of the above cited High Court Judgement and above quoted pronouncement of the prescribed Authority (Lt. Gover-nor), recognition of no school shall lapse as specified under Rule 54(2). Recognition once grant shall be absolute.

Hence no school will be deemed recognised for a limited period, no matter whether it was recognised prior to the commencement of the Act/Rt 1973 or has been granted recognition thereafter. Hence-forth all recognischools shall be deemed to be permanently recognised and recognition coul be withdrawn only through the procedure laid down under sub-sec. (6) of Section 4 of the Act road with Rulewah of Delhi School Education Rules, 19
